Seek medical treatment if you show symptoms including fever, cough or shortness of breath, particularly if you have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19 or if you have recently traveled from an area with widespread or ongoing community spread of COVID-19.

Frequently wash your hands. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth. Cover your mouth and nose – with a tissue, if possible – when coughing or sneezing, then properly discard the tissue in the trash.

Avoid close contact with anyone else who is coughing or sneezing or who is otherwise sick. Clean or disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces. Practice “social distancing” by minimizing close contact with others and avoiding large gatherings.
